This led to another definition with a broader set of activities that focused on markets and included natural resources: “Agribusiness is a dynamic and systemic endeavor that serves consumers globally and locally through innovation and management of multiple value chains that deliver valued goods and services derived from the sustainable orchestration of food, fiber, and natural resources.” (Edwards & Schultz, 2005).
