Albedo is a measure of how much solar energy is reflected by a material. Pavements with lower albedo tend to absorb more solar energy, resulting in higher pavement temperatures, whereas pavements with higher albedo typically absorb less solar energy, resulting in cooler pavement temperatures.

Lighter color surfaces reflect light and have a high albedo, while darker surfaces absorb light and have a low albedo. Albedo is measured on a scale of 0-1. A 0 means that the surface of a material absorbs all of the sunlight that hits it. A 1 means that a material reflects all of the light energy that hits it. In other words, a 1 on the albedo scale means 100 percent reflection.

Efforts to mitigate the UHI effect focus on trees and vegetation, cool roofs, and cool pavements, which mitigate and prevent the absorption of solar radiation. This reflective property, known as albedo, measures the

percentage of solar energy reflected by a surface. The albedo of pavement surfaces differs greatly by the materials used in construction:

The thermal performance of a pavement is defined as the change in its temperature (most often surface temperature) over time as influenced by properties of the paving materials (e.g. albedo, thermal emittance, thermal conductivity, specific heat, and surface convection) and by the ambient environmental conditions (sunlight, wind, air temperature).

Explaining Albedo

Albedo is a dimensionless fraction and is measured on a scale from 0 to 1. Albedo of 0 means no reflecting power of a perfectly black surface (none reflected, all absorbed), Albedo of 1 means perfect reflection of a perfectly white surface (100% reflected) [26, 27].

Asphalt concrete, the most common material used for pavement, is dark and has a low albedo (a measure of solar reflectance). Cement concrete is lighter, and thus has a higher albedo, but it requires a high-temperature process that is considerably more energy- and carbon-intensive than making asphalt from petroleum.
