Reference List. In-text Citation. Basic Format:Last name, A. A. (Year).Title of article. Title of Journal, Volume number (issue number if available), pages.Example: Scruton, R. (1996).The eclipse of listening. The New Criterion, 15(3), 5-13. Note: The name of the author is reversed with the last name first followed by the initials.

APA Journal Citation | APA Format

APA style dictates that authors are named with their last name followed by their initials; publication year goes between parentheses, followed by a period. The title of the article is in sentence-case, meaning only the first word and proper nouns in the title are capitalized.

Reference List: Articles in Periodicals // Purdue Writing Lab

If a journal article has a DOI, include the DOI in the reference. Always include the issue number for a journal article. If the journal article does not have a DOI and is from an academic research database, end the reference after the page range (for an explanation of why, see the database information page).The reference in this case is the same as for a print journal article.

APA format details a set of clear rules for referencing articles that appear in academic journals and other periodicals. These vary somewhat based on where the article appears and who the authors are.

How to Reference Journal Articles in APA Format

When a journal article has eight or more authors: References List List the first six authors followed by three spaced ellipse points (. . .) and then the last author's name.

For an APA citation for a journal article with 2 to 20 authors, use a comma between all of the author names. Place an ampersand (&) before the final author's name. Place an ampersand (&) before the final author's name.

The article name comes next, followed by the title of the journal (in italics), volume number (in italics) and issue number in parentheses. End with the page numbers.

When using APA format, follow the author-date method of in-text citation. This means that the author's last name and the year of publication for the source should appear in the text, for example, (Jones, 1998), and a complete reference should appear in the reference list at the end of the paper.

If page numbers of an article run consecutively, separate beginning and ending page numbers with a hyphen. End citation with a period. If the pages of the article do not run consecutively, indicate the beginning page of the article followed by a + sign.

In APA Style, no matter the type of periodical, they all follow the same reference format. However, the specific pieces of information included in the source element vary (e.g., references for journal articles and magazines generally include volumes and issues, whereas references for newspaper articles do not).

The "Issue" with Issue Numbers in Journal Articles

If you are referencing the name of a journal, the journal name would be in italics. Example:Studies published in the Journal of Abnormal Psychology found that If you are referencing the name of an article, the article name is in quotations.

Write a summary The introductory paragraph of the review should provide a brief summary of the article, strictly limiting it to one to three paragraphs depending on the article length.
