FHA Appraisal Requirements for Swimming Pools In a section entitled "Appraiser and Property Requirements," the FHA handbook states: The Appraiser is required to report any "readily observable defects" that might render a swimming pool inoperable or unusable.

Swimming Pools Swimming pools are permitted under current FHA property requirements, but the Mortgagee / lender must ensure that the pool complies with all local safety laws and ordinances. For instance, in some cities swimming pools are required to have a safety barrier of some kind.

By contrast, swimming pool rules that banned children under the age of 5 from the pool, and that limited pool use to 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. for children between 5 and 16 were found to be in violation of the FHA as too restrictive and/or not tailored to real safety considerations. Another common target of the FHA is "adult swim" periods.

CONSIDER FHA REGULATION WHEN WRITING POOL RULES

For functioning pools, the main guidance is: "At minimum, swimming pools, must comply with all local ordinances (perimeter fencing, covers, etc.)..." As you can see, this leaves the research up to the appraiser and the lender to decide what is complying with local ordinances and what is not.

FHA guidance maintains that the more it appears that a pool is available for the public's use, the more likely ADA rules will apply. Also under the FHA, apartment management must not discriminate against a disabled resident in the use of a given community's amenities.

Swimming Pool Requirements for FHA Loan First of all, if the appraiser determines an uncovered pool to be inoperable or unusable, reasons must be stated. For a pool to contribute value, it must be operational. When a pool has algae or looks unappealing, but there is no proof of contamination, cleaning is not required.

Swimming Pools - Swimming pools must comply with all local ordinances (perimeter fencing, covers, etc.). Swimming pools must be operational to provide Contributory Value. The appraiser must report readily observable defects in a non-covered pool that would render the pool inoperable or unusable.

While it is necessary to establish pool safety rules, boards must be careful not to draft such rules in a manner that may violate the Federal Fair Housing Act of 1968 and its amendments ("FHA"), which prohibit housing providers from discriminating in the terms, conditions, or privileges of sale or rental of a dwelling or in the provision of services in connection therewith on the basis of a protected class.

A swimming pools FHA inspector will have a list of standards with which the home's pool must comply before closing on the sale can be scheduled. If the pool is empty, you will have to fill it sufficiently so that the pump can be used to circulate water and to ensure that the pool holds water adequately.
