The Top 6 Examples of Quality Improvement in Healthcare

Continuous quality improvement (CQI) or total quality management (TQM) is a seven-step process that consists of the identification of desired knowledge, design of appropriate measures to obtain the necessary assessments, measurement, investigation of the measurements to find trends and best practices, return of that information to those who can effect change, implementation of change in practice to increase the incidence of best practice, and then remeasurement to assess the program of change.
