For example the International Society for the Advancement of Kinanthropometry accreditation system for anthropometrists has operated since 1996 with the aim of establishing a global standard for anthropometry. Over 3,000 anthropometrists from 49 countries have been accredited in anthropometric measurement techniques under this scheme . Adoption of these criteria allows standardisation of measurements between participants and of repeated measurements on the same participants.
