The narratives about Jesus came directly from the eyewitnesses. Bauckham's thesis is that the eyewitnesses stand directly behind our written Gospels. He argues that in the ancient world historiographic best practice was to interview eyewitnesses (9), and this is exactly what Luke did before he wrote his Gospel (34; cf. Luke 1:1-4).
