How to Recognize Symptoms of Suicidal Behavior

During the conversation, make sure you: stay calm and speak in a reassuring tone acknowledge that their feelings are legitimate offer support and encouragement tell them that help is available and that they can feel better with treatment

On average, 112 Americans die by suicide each day. Suicide is the second leading cause of death among 15-24 year olds and more than 9.4 million adults in the United States had serious thoughts of suicide within the past 12 months.
