In the positive form, for regular verbs, add an -edto the verb. But many verbs are irregular. Some of the most common are: go—went, buy—bought, take—took, come—came, have—had, eat—ate, and drink—drank. There are many irregular verbs, so you will need to start learning them now.

### A Beginner's Guide to the Simple Past in English

These forms are the infinitive, simple present, simple past, past participle, and present participle. The difference between a regular and an irregular verb is the formation of the simple past and past participle. Regular verbs are dependably consistent—the simple past ends in ed as does the past participle. In contrast, the simple past and past participle of irregular verbs can end in a variety of ways, with absolutely no consistent pattern.

### Grammar Bytes! - Rules for Using Irregular Verbs

Only the verb "be" changes its form for the singular or plural. All the other verbs, regular and irregular, use one form in the past tense, which makes the past tense a little easier to use when making statements. More practice with this important verb ("be") comes in Lesson 16.

### The Past Tense in English

The basic structure of tenses for regular verbs and irregular verbs is exactly the same (except the verb be). The only difference is that with regular verbs the past simple and past participle are always the same (worked, worked), while with irregular verbs the past simple and past participle are NOT always the same (sang, sung).

The trend, in English, and especially in American English, is to standardize the irregular verbs. We do not foresee all the irregular verbs ever being standardized, but some of the more minor variations in less commonly used words will probably disappear in the next generation or two. The following English irregular verbs are now obsolete and use the standard past and participle forms (-ed).
